Provision of Facilities Management Services at Bolsover District Council

To seek approval to extend the Facilities Management Services contract for Council owned buildings for a period of six months

Compliance with the requirement to give 28 clear days and 5 clear days notice in accordance with the above Regulations is impracticable as the matter is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred.

Reason for urgency: Extension of existing contract for a period of six months to ensure continued provision whilst services are re-tendered
