Purpose of the Report

 To seek approval to award the contract for the Provision of Asbestos Surveying and Sampling Services to Environtec Ltd to Council Owned Commercial & Domestic properties for Bolsover District Council, utilising the Efficiency East Midlands (EEM) Framework.

1 Report Details

- 1.1 The existing contract for the Provision of Asbestos Surveying and Sampling Services has expired and in line with current procurement guidelines it was agreed that a mini tender would be undertaken utilising an existing EEM framework
- 1.2 The indicative spend will be £100,000 per year, and this is contained within existing budgets.
- 1.3 Four contractors provided tender submissions and after the evaluation process based upon 70% cost and 30% quality it was Environtec Ltd who came out clear winners. See evaluation table below

2 Conclusions and Reasons for Recommendation

- 2.1 It is recommended that the contract be awarded to Environtec Ltd based upon an initial 2 year contract with the option to extend the contract for two further periods each of one year. The award of any extension is conditional on the performance of the Contractor.
- 2.2 It is anticipated based upon the new schedule of rates provided by the new contractor that savings will be around 25% per year.
