Chesterfield College

We have developed an excellent relationship with Chesterfield College and have worked closely with them over the last few months to develop a work experience programme for a number of

their students to complete their work experience placements at New Bolsover Model Village.



Students from a number of trades including Brickwork and Joinery, were given the opportunity to learn valuable employability skills whilst on site.

The students were given careers talk and undertook Mock CSCS (Health & Safety) training and testing before coming on site.

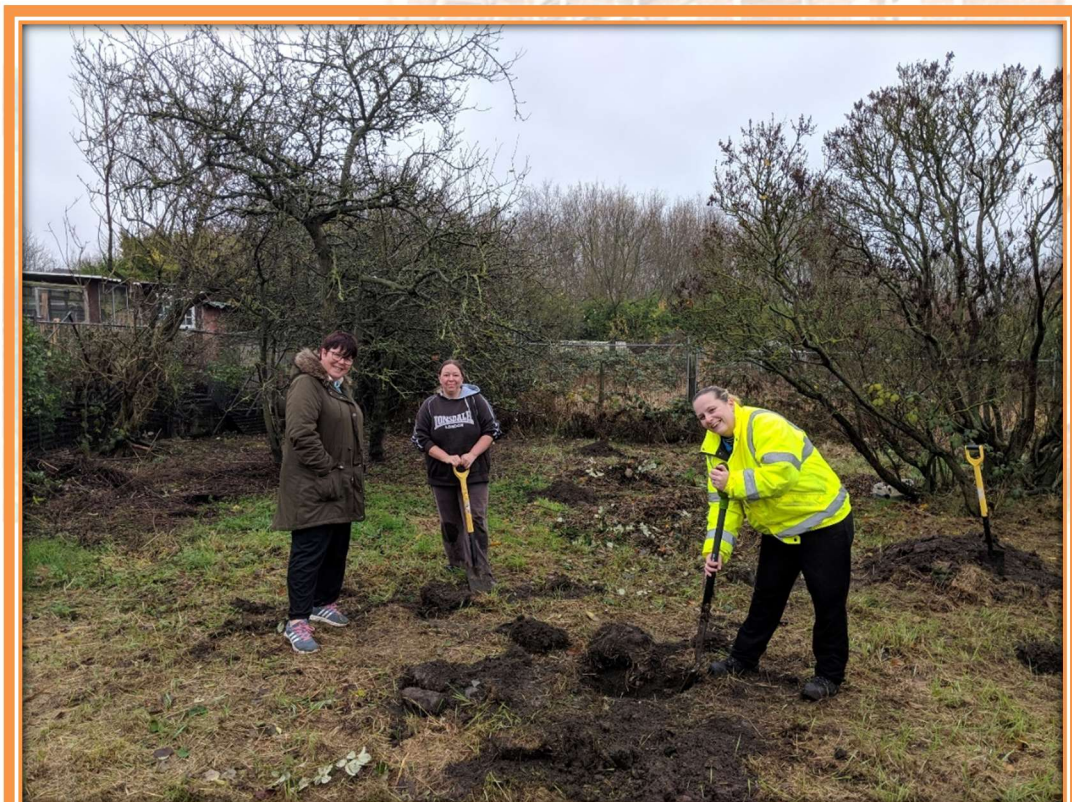
