AGENDA ITEM 2. URGENT ITEMS OF BUSINESS

We have been notified by the Planning Inspectorate of a valid Planning Appeal (Ref: APP/R1010/W/23/3320946) against planning application 22/00333/FUL for Willow Tree Family Farm, Langwith Road, Mansfield, Nottinghamshire, NG20 8TF

The application was refused planning permission by Planning Committee on 21st December 2022 contrary to officer advice, and therefore the preparation of the Council's Statement of Case will need to take place in consultation with the Planning Committee.

On page 15 of the agenda pack, the summary should read ...

The recommendation is to refuse the application because the site is within the open countryside and the proposal does not meet the requirements of Local Plan Policies SS9 (Development in the Countryside,) LC7 (Agricultural, Forestry and Other Occupational Dwellings in the Countryside) and SS1 (Sustainable Development).

On page 21 of the agenda pack, paragraph 3, the speed limit of Mansfield Road is incorrectly stated as 60mph. The speed limit on Mansfield Road is 50mph (as detailed elsewhere in the officer report).
