

The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulations 5 and 11 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 that the following key decision is intended to be made by officer delegated decision.


To enter into a lease agreement as specified on Exempt DD 0133/KH/030723

Compliance with the requirement to give 28 clear days' notice in accordance with the above Regulations is impracticable as the matter is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred.

Reason for urgency: To meet an immediate deadline.

The DD is exempt and will be considered in private to avoid the disclosure of exempt information as defined in paragraph 3 of Part 1 of Schedule 12A to the Local Government Act 1972 (as amended by the Local Government (Access to information) (Variation) Order 2006).

The decision is urgent and one that is not subject to call-in. The Chair of the Local Growth Scrutiny Committee has been consulted in accordance with Scrutiny Procedure Rules and has agreed that it is urgent and not subject to call-in.
