Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulation 10 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 that the following key decision is intended to be made at the above Meeting of Executive. This was not included the List of Key Decisions and Items to be Considered in Private which was issued on 8th September 2023.

Lease of Roseland Park and Crematorium

To set out the next steps in relation to the lease of Roseland Park and Crematorium in line with expert advice provided on the VAT partial exemption calculation.

Compliance with the requirements to give 28 clear days notice in accordance with the above Regulation is impracticable.

Reason for urgency: The Council has been waiting for advice regarding the VAT partial exemption calculation. This has now been received and the next steps in relation to the lease of Roseland Park and Crematorium can be reported to Executive. A decision on the lease needs to be made in order not to delay the project.

The Chairs of the Local Growth Scrutiny Committee and Finance and Corporate Overview Scrutiny Committee have been informed of the decision to be taken.
