CIVICAPAY BOS CONTRACT

Compliance with the requirements to give 28 clear days' notice in accordance with the above Regulation is impracticable.

Reason for urgency: The Council uses CivicaPay which is set up for the Council. To swap suppliers would necessitate a tender process which would result in the Council losing discount for the current proposed contract and a new system would need setting up from scratch and require significant and comprehensive support from IT. It would also result in down time and customers would not be able to pay their bills on line or via a contact centre

The Chair of the Council has been informed of this urgency and has agreed it is exempt from Scrutiny Call-in.
