Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulation 10 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 that the following key decision is intended to be made by the Chief Executive Officer by Delegated Authority.


This was not included on the List Of Key Decisions And Items To Be Considered In Private document which was issued on 8th November 2024.

Service Level Agreement - Household Support Fund 6

Compliance with the requirements to give 28 clear days' notice in accordance with the above Regulation is impracticable.

Reason for urgency: The household support fund 6 is a 6 month Grant (1st October 2024 to 31st March 2025) to provide support to vulnerable households who would otherwise struggle to buy food or pay essential utility bills, essential living costs and housing costs. This grant is an opportunity to financially assist vulnerable households across the district, to prevent homelessness and to sustain tenancies. In order to receive this grant of £103,017 the Service Level Agreement needs to be signed. To not enter into the SLA would mean that Bolsover residents do not benefit from the grant.

The Chair of Customer Services Scrutiny Committee has been informed of the decision to be taken and has agreed the decision is urgent and not subject to Scrutiny Call-in.
