Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulation 11 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 that the following key decision is intended to be made at the above meeting of Executive. This was not included the List Of Key Decisions and Items to be considered In private document which was issued on 19th November 2024.

Appointment of Contractor to complete flood mitigation works at Pleasley Vale Business Park

Compliance with the requirement to give 5 clear days' notice in accordance with the above Regulation is impracticable as the matter is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred.

Reason for urgency: There is an urgent need to undertake works at Pleasley Vale following the flood damage caused by storm Babet last year. Effectively managing flood risk and protecting the site from future extreme weather events is of paramount importance if the site is to continue operations. It is also important to establish a baseline of flood modelling to inform any future development proposals for the wider site, as any planning application would require detailed flood risk assessments to be undertaken as part of any application.

Due to the urgent need to undertake the work the Chair of Local Growth Scrutiny Committee has agreed that it should be treated as a matter of urgency and not be subject to the Scrutiny call-in process.
