The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012


Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulation 11 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 that the following key decision is intended to be made by way of Delegated Decision by the Chief Executive. This was not included on the List Of Key Decisions And Items To Be Considered In Private document which was issued on 25th April 2025.

To award an Electrical Works contract to Sureserve to undertake void repairs and annual testing to domestic properties following a procurement process undertaken through EEM

Compliance with the requirement to give 5 clear days' notice in accordance with the above Regulation is impracticable as the matter is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred.

Reason for urgency: The contract with the electrical works contractor tendered for in 2024 has ended. In order to not cause further delay to void timescales and begin a new contract from the 1st April 2025, to award the Electrical Works contract to Sureserve to undertake void repairs and annual testing to domestic properties following a procurement process undertaken through EEM.

The Chair of the Customer Services Scrutiny Committee has been informed of the decision to be taken and has agreed that the decision is not subject to Scrutiny Call-In.
