Local Government Reorganisation Submission

Compliance with the requirements to give 28 clear days' notice in accordance with the above Regulation is impracticable.

Reason for urgency: There is insufficient time between the Executive meeting and the Government's deadline for submission of Local Government Reorganisation proposals. The Council will be considering the proposals at an Extraordinary Council meeting immediately prior to the Extraordinary Executive on 5th November 2025 where all Members will be given the opportunity to ask questions and discuss the report.
