The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulation 10 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 that the following key decision is intended to be made at the above Meeting of Executive. This was not included the List Of Key Decisions And Items To Be Considered In Private which was issued on 26th June 2020.

To create a fixed term four year planning apprenticeship post within the Planning Enforcement Team

Compliance with the requirements to give 28 clear days notice in accordance with the above Regulation is impracticable.

Reason for urgency: The Council has to be able to give the supplier of the apprenticeship certainty that the post holder will be employed by the Council for the four year period before the apprenticeship can be guaranteed to be paid for through the apprenticeship levy and before the post holder is able to join the apprenticeship. If the Council is unable to provide that certainty before the start of September then the post holder would not be able to start their apprenticeship until next year's intake in September 2021.

The Chair of the Growth Scrutiny Committee has been informed of the decision to be taken.
