## The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulation 5 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 that the following exempt report is intended to be considered in private at the above Meeting of Executive. This was not included the List Of Key Decisions And Items To Be Considered In Private which was issued on 4<sup>th</sup> March 2022.

## **Consideration of a Discretionary Disabled Facilities Grant**

Compliance with the requirement to give 28 clear days notice in accordance with the above Regulation is impracticable as the matter is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred.

**Reason for urgency:** the decision relates to the health and welfare of disabled residents, and other funding sources have been explored unsuccessfully. To delay this decision further could put vulnerable residents at risk.

This report is exempt and it is proposed that it be considered in private to avoid the disclosure of exempt information as defined in paragraph 1 of Part 1 of Schedule 12A to the Local Government Act 1972 (as amended by the Local Government (Access to information)(Variation) Order 2006).

The Chair of the Customer Services Scrutiny Committee has been informed of the decision to be taken in respect of the exempt report and has consented to consideration of the report being held in private at the above meeting of Executive.
