Notice is hereby given in accordance with Regulations 5 and 10 of the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 that the following key decision to be made in private at the above Meeting of Executive. This was not included the List of Key Decisions and Items to be Considered in Private which was issued on 30th September 2022.

Letting of Oxcroft House, Bolsover

Compliance with the requirement to give 28 clear days notice in accordance with the above Regulations is impracticable as the matter is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred.

Reason for urgency: To avoid the Council losing rental income for a commercial property.
