REASON FOR DECISION: To approve the content of the Annual Housing Ombudsman Complaints Report and Self-Assessment 2024/25 to ensure corporate compliance with the Housing Ombudsman Complaint Handling Code and the Councils CCC Policy. OTHER OPTIONS CONSIDERED: The Annual Housing Ombudsman Complaints Report and Self-Assessment 2024/25 is a requirement of the Housing Ombudsman Complaint Handling Code.

8 Budget Monitoring Report Quarter 1

RESOLVED that 1) the monitoring position of the General Fund at the end of the first quarter as detailed on Appendix 1 to the report, (a net favourable variance of £0.903m against the profiled budget) and the key issues highlighted within this report.

2) the position on the Housing Revenue Account (HRA), the Capital Programme and Treasury Management at the end of the first quarter (as detailed at Appendices 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 to the report) be noted.

REASON FOR DECISION:

The report summarised the financial position of the Council following the first quarter's budget monitoring exercise for the General Fund, the Housing Revenue Account, Capital Programme and Treasury Management activity.

The Medium-Term Financial Strategy (MTFS) for 2025/26 – 2028/29 was approved in October 2024. It was the Section 151 Officer's intention to update the strategy on an annual basis for the implications of each finance settlement, to carry forward the assumptions for the new year of the MTFP and present to Members for approval.

However, the uncertainty currently surrounding Government funding and the Fair Funding Review 2.0 consultation, meant the Section 151 Officer was not in a position to provide an update to the strategy at this time.

The Section 151 Officer would therefore update Members on the government funding implications for Bolsover District Council and the MTFP, in the MTFP report in January 2026, and update the MTFS as usual in September and October 2026

OTHER OPTIONS CONSIDERED:

The Budget Monitoring report for 2025/26 was primarily a factual report which details progress against previously approved budgets. Accordingly, there were no alternative options to consider.

9	Management of Corporate Debt - Write off of outstanding amounts	RESOLVED that the outstanding amount included at paragraph 2.1 of the report (£22,662.68) and detailed in Appendix 1, be written off.
		REASON FOR DECISION: Given that all available options to recover the debt had been explored, it was important that the Council recognised the position and approved the write-off of the uncollectable debt.
