

Fire Action

IF THE FIRE IS NOT IN YOUR OWN FLAT

- Stay in your own flat unless you are affected by heat or smoke

IF THE FIRE IS IN YOUR OWN FLAT

- Warn everybody in your flat that there is a fire
- Ensure that everybody leaves the flat
- Close the front door behind you to stop the fire spreading

If there is a lot of smoke, stay low or crawl along the floor where the air will be clearer

DO NOT WEDGE FIRE DOORS OPEN

DIAL 999 TO CALL THE FIRE SERVICE

- Give the address of the building on fire



NO SMOKING
