

Fire Action

IF THE FIRE IS NOT IN YOUR OWN FLAT:

 Stay in your own flat unless you are affected by heat or smoke

DO NOT WEDGE FIRE DOORS OPEN OR TAMPER WITH FIRE DOORS

IF THE FIRE IS IN YOUR OWN FLAT:

- · Warn everybody in your flat that there is a fire
- Ensure that everybody leaves the flat
- Close the flat entrance door behind you to stop the fire spreading
- Do not run or collect personal belongings

DIAL 999 TO CALL THE FIRE SERVICE

· Give the address of the building on fire

If there is a lot of smoke, stay low or crawl along the floor where the air will be clearer.

IF THE FIRE IS IN THE COMMON AREA:

- · Evacuate immediately, closing doors behind you
- Do not collect personal belongings


ASSEMBLY POINT
