

Fire Action

IF THE FIRE IS NOT IN YOUR OWN FLAT:

- Stay in your own flat unless you are affected by heat or smoke

IF THE FIRE IS IN YOUR OWN FLAT:

- Warn everybody in your flat that there is a fire
- Ensure that everybody leaves the flat
- Close the flat entrance door behind you to stop the fire spreading
- Do not run or collect personal belongings

IF THE FIRE IS IN THE COMMON AREA:

- Evacuate immediately, closing doors behind you
- Do not collect personal belongings

DO NOT WEDGE FIRE DOORS OPEN OR TAMPER WITH FIRE DOORS

DIAL 999 TO CALL THE FIRE SERVICE

- Give the address of the building on fire

If there is a lot of smoke, stay low or crawl along the floor where the air will be clearer.

ASSEMBLY POINT

- Please move to the kerbside away from the property

COMMUNAL LANDINGS AND STAIRCASES MUST BE KEPT CLEAR AT ALL TIMES
