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### **Report of the Portfolio Holder – Partnerships and Transformation**

#### **Purpose of the Report**

- The Partnership Strategy and Policy team have direct responsibility for agreeing to produce a Sustainable Community Strategy (SCS) for Bolsover district. This, together with ensuring consultation takes place via Bolsover Partnership as the vehicle that brings together the 4 sectors of public, private, community and voluntary to agree priorities within the Strategy.
- This SCS spans the same period of time as our Council Plan to promote alignment of priorities and to assist the performance monitoring element for the Council and its partners.

#### **1 Report Details**

- 1.1 The previous Sustainable Community Strategy was agreed in 2006 with a 15 year timespan. Each year a review was undertaken in terms of reviewing performance against targets and priorities and agreeing new ones for the coming year with Partnership Action Groups.
- 1.2 In 2019 the final review was undertaken and plans began to consult on producing a new Strategy.
- 1.3 Council are being asked today to endorse the new document for the next 4 years with reviews to take place annually.
- 1.4 An official launch is planned through Bolsover Partnership at their next AGM to be held in April 2020.

- 2.1 Members and officers feel that the priorities reflected in the new Strategy align to the Council's Plan and that agreeing the timeline of 2020-2023 is sensible to ensure appropriate and meaningful performance reports
