o To report the quarter 3 outturns for the Corporate Plan 2019-2020 targets.

1 Report Details

- 1.1 The attached contains the performance outturn for targets which sit under the 'unlocking our growth potential' aim as of 31st December 2019 (Information compiled on 29th January 2019)
- 1.2 A summary is provided below:

1.3 Unlocking our Growth Potential

- 7 targets in total
- 5 targets on track
- 1 target has been achieved this quarter
 - O G 05 Through the Bolsover North East Derbyshire LEADER Approach collectively support the creation of 40 sustainable jobs in the combined programme area by December 2020. The programme closed nationally to new applications on 30th September 2019 and no further applications will be considered. Due to several individual projects cost savings, the amount contracted/claimed by the 37 approved projects totals £1,233,675.63 from an original award of £1,248,695.88. 68.82 jobs created.
- ➤ 1 target on Alert i.e. they may not achieve their intended outcomes
 - G 11 Through a programme of targeted refurbishment bring 10 empty private sector properties back into use per annum. To date no properties brought back into use. 7 properties are in the process of being brought back into use. Once these have been completed, this should create 12 units of accommodation. See appendix for further information.

- 2.1 Out of the 7 targets, 5 (71%) are on track, 1 (14%) on alert and 1 (14%) achieved.
